



Top spot in the European research landscape, but...


- ✓ An excellent range of science and research facilities:
 - 9 universities
 - 48 universities of applied sciences
 - over 100 research institutes
 - 38 technology centres
- ✓ Private investment in R&D
 - a broad range, <u>but</u> not enough
 - lack of resources (including capital)
- √ Knowledge + technology transfer
 - planned development and optimisation of structures

Cross-cluster innovations and sustainability (2018 to 2020)









Organizational structure of the clusters


